

What is Omishima Island like?

Omishima used to consist of two parts, Omishima Town and Kamiura Town until it was merged with Imabari City in 2005. Even now, these names are in use. There are 13 areas in this island, and many of their names are difficult to read. How many names can you read? Let's try. (The answer is in pages 35 and 36.) In pages $3\sim14$, we are reporting about Kamiura Town, the eastern part of Omishima, and on pages $15\sim34$, Omishima Town, the western part. Of particular note is the special points in Miyaura Area, where Oymazumi Shrine is located (from p.17 to 32).

In the latter half, you can see various articles like marvelous landscapes worth uploading to SNS, wild boars drawing attention as a new-style industry, art museums in Omishima, and so on.
